

Personal Property Identification Record

If you are a victim of a burglary it is important to know the serial numbers of the items stolen. Without positive identification made possible by a serial number – or a unique number, which you may engrave on your property – you may not be able, to prove you are the rightful owner if the item is recovered. A couple tips:

- Take photo's of the items (remember to print them out or upload them to your e-mail, it is not helpful if they are in your stolen camera)
- **Record serial numbers** (these can typically be found on the bottom of the device or if you can't find it google the item or call the manufacturer)
- Record the value of the item (this is helpful especially if you attempt to file a claim with your insurance)
