- if u see illegal dumping, call 311
- you can also call 911 for illegal dumping. It is a crime.
- last 3 months, made 6 arrests for illegal dumping.
- illegal dumping: truck loads of dumping in vacant lots, corner, etc.
- there are 3 investigators in the city so sometimes they may seem slow but they will get to you
 - if times are directly in front of your property, then the property lender can be fined.
- --the moving/construction dumpster permits come from DDOT and

usually last 60 days

- --when reporting let them know the location of the dumpster
- -resident concern: called 311 but they didn't come pick up Until few weeks later. Make sure you keep the confirmation #.
- --if residents feel the need for education around this, call 311 and they will come
- --will look into having LeDroit park dump day and have a dumpster
 - call 311 for graffiti removal as well
